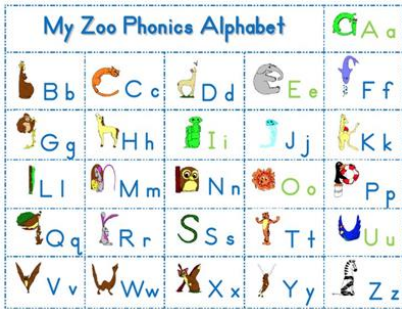

During the month of October we will be continuing our Zoophonics curriculum which is a multi-sensory approach to learning the alphabet and the letter sounds. In this program each letter is paired with an animal who has a name, that shares the letters phonemic sound and a motion.
